Dear Impact Central Illinois Membership:

The last year brought on many challenges for our group, the communities and the organizations who support the community. The year also brought blessings. With the growth of our membership and the gift from the Gilmore Foundation we were able to grant two Impact grants for a total of \$205,000. We were also able to an in-person annual meeting. The air was electrifying as we heard from program details from our five finalists. We the membership selected The Center for Prevention and Abuse and St. Paul and Urban Acres.

The organization raised \$205,000 in grant funds; \$180,000 from membership and \$25,000 from the Gilmore Foundation. These funds are set aside and will be distributed to our grantees over the next 24 months. The organization's spending was \$9,632 of which 84.6% was spent on programs and 15.4% on administrative. Programs included the January Inspire, non-profit information sessions and our annual meeting. Spending has been monitored and kept low due to the diligence of the board, committee chairs and the generosity of our members for in-kind donations. Thank you to all.

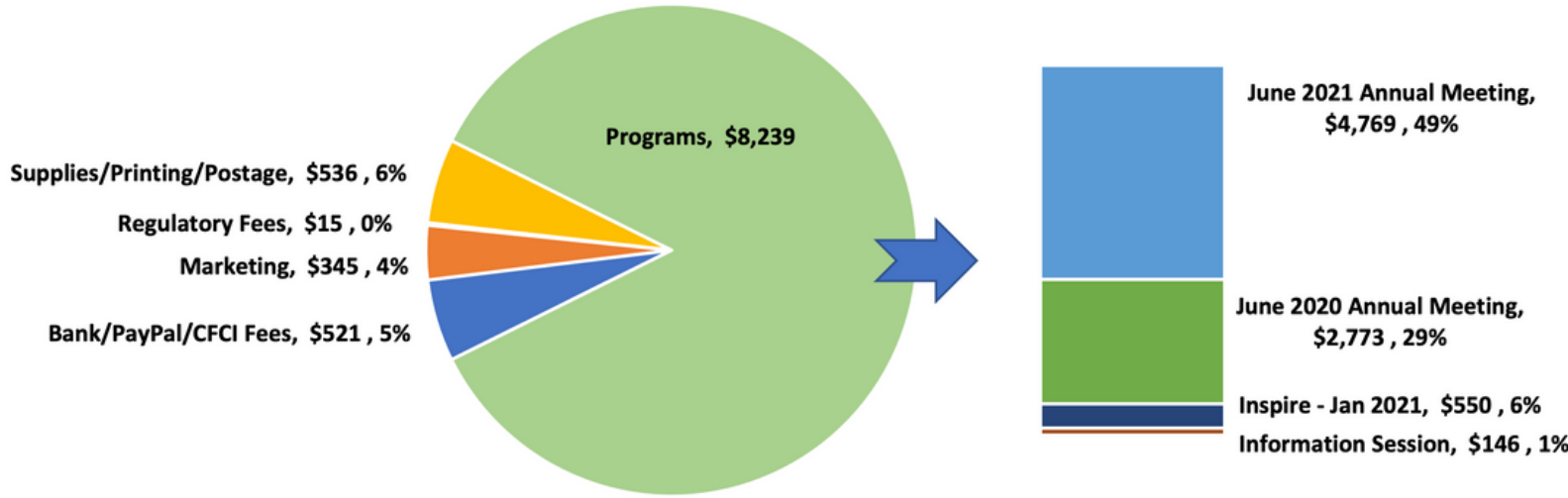
