Impact Central Illinois has the desire to support programs or projects being proposed by a **Highly Capable** organization to address a **Measurable Need** within our community with an **Innovative Solution**

Highly Capable

- Has performed supportive background research in developing their proposal
- Demonstrates prior
 experience or personnel
 capability to bring their
 proposal to fruition
- Defines an achievable plan of action
- Clarifies and understands any proposal partnerships
- Displays financial integrity through a clear description of proposal budget and an understanding of how to proceed if their proposal is not fully funded.

Measurable Need

- States the Central Illinois problem/need w/measurable statistics
- Demonstrates the risk if the proposal is not implemented now
- Can define the impact on beneficiaries and has involved beneficiaries in definition of the proposal
- Contains a plan to measure, monitor, & evaluate
- Envisions the benefits that go beyond the immediate proposal

Innovative Solution

(should display at least one of the following)

- Plays a unique role in the community (minimizing a duplication of efforts with other programs in the community)
- Takes a calculated risk tackling a large-scale issue or the root-cause of an issue facing our community
- Adapts national/global ideas locally
- Repurposes an older tool for a new purpose
- Employs innovative or sustainable funding revenue streams to support the proposal or introduces new capabilities to the organization
